AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ROCHESTER APPROXIMATELY 3.27 ACRES OF LANDS SITUATED IN A PORTION OF THE WEST HALF OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 106 NORTH, RANGE 14 WEST, OLMSTED COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. A petition has been initiated by the Common Council of the City of Rochester requesting the annexation of said land to the City of Rochester. The land described in said petition for annexation is located in Rochester Township, Olmsted County, Minnesota, and is described as follows:

That part of the West Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 15, Township 106 North, Range 14 West, Olmsted County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of said West Half of the Northeast Quarter; thence southerly on a Minnesota State Plane Grid Azimuth from north of 178 degrees 07 minutes 06 seconds along the east line of said West Half of the Northeast Quarter 1094.32 feet to the southwesterly corner of Woodland Hills, according to the plat thereof on file at the County Recorder's Office, Olmsted County, Minnesota, and the point of beginning; thence southwesterly 208 degrees 04 minutes 02 seconds azimuth 200.31 feet; thence southwesterly 241 degrees 20 minutes 54 seconds azimuth 280.01 feet; thence southerly 178 degrees 07 minutes 06 seconds azimuth 237.74 feet; thence easterly 88 degrees 07 minutes 06 seconds azimuth 180.00 feet; thence southerly 178 degrees 07 minutes 06 seconds azimuth 130.00 feet; thence easterly 88 degrees 07 minutes 06 seconds azimuth 170.00 feet to the east line of said West Half of the Northeast Quarter; thence northerly 358 degrees 07 minutes 06 seconds azimuth along said east line 667.42 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 3.27 acres more or less.

Section 2. The quantity of land included in said petition is approximately 3.27 acres in size.

Section 3. The Common Council of the City of Rochester does hereby determine that the land described in Section 1 abuts upon the present territorial limits of the City of Rochester, contains less than 60 acres, the petition is signed by all the landowners involved, and the annexation of said land will be in the best interest of the City of Rochester and the land described.

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Section 4. Therefore, the land described in Section 1 above is hereby annexed, added to and made a part of the City of Rochester, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. Present and future owners of the lands annexed by this ordinance are hereby notified that in addition to the usual assessments, it is the intention of the Common Council to assess against benefitted property all or a portion of the cost of any storm sewer, water tower, pumping station, and trunk line sanitary sewer construction, heretofore or hereafter undertaken to serve the area annexed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its official publication and from and after the filing of a certified copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal board, the Rochester Town Clerk, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State.
