AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NEW GERMANY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, the Petition of Viola Schroeder ("Petitioner") was filed with the City of New Germany on July 27, 1994 to annex certain land into the corporate limits of the City of New Germany, Minnesota for the purpose of residential development; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioner represents all of the fee owners of the property for which annexation is sought; and

WHEREAS, the area proposed for annexation constitutes approximately 34.18 acres and as such, notice to the Camden Town Board and the Minnesota Municipal Board is not required; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner seeks annexation to develop the property for residential purposes and the City of New Germany has available the necessary municipal services for residential development which are only available if the property is within its corporate limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW GERMANY, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. <u>DECLARATION</u>. It is hereby determined that the annexation of the land described in Section 2 below for the purpose of residential development would be in the best interest of the City of New Germany.

SECTION 2. TERRITORY ANNEXED. The corporate limits of the City of New Germany are hereby extended to encompass and embrace all of the territory described as follows and said land is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

That part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 4, Township 116, Range 26 as more particularly described on attached Exhibit A, excepting therefrom that part thereof which already lies within the corporate limits of the City of New Germany.

SECTION 3. FILING. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Municipal Board of the State of Minnesota, the Minnesota Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Carver County and the Clerk of Camden Township as required by law.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ANNEXATION. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3 and shall be deemed final

upon approval of this Ordinance by the Municipal Board of the State of Minnesota.
