ORDINANCE 23-96

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF JORDAN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY BORDERED BY LAND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not now included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, 50% or more of the perimeter of this territory is bordered by land within the city limits of the City of Jordan; and

WHEREAS, this territory is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; and

WHEREAS, one hundred percent (100%) of the owners of this territory have petitioned the City of Jordan for annexation for said territory into the City of Jordan; and

WHEREAS, the Sand Creek Township Board has waived its right to object to the annexation of said territory; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jordan is able to provide urban services to the territory, including sanitary sewer, watermain, police and fire;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Jordan ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Jordan, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows:

That part of the west half of the northwest quarter (W 1/2 of NW 1/4) of Section 30, Township 114, Range 23, Scott County, Minnesota, except the north 1,432.50 feet thereof.

Section 2. Filing. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the Scott County Auditor, the Town Clerk of Sand Creek Township and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

Section 3. Population. The population of the annexed territory is zero (0).

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2 and approval by the Minnesota Municipal Board.
