THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES PURSUANT)	<u>AND</u>
TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414)	<u>ORDER TO DISMISS</u>

WHEREAS, a petition for the annexation of certain land to the City of Detroit Lakes was filed with the Minnesota Municipal Board pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.033, Subd. 3 with the Minnesota Municipal Board on December 14, 1999; and

WHEREAS, an objection from Lake View Township was received by the Municipal Board on February 25, 1999; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 1999, the Board granted the joint request of the parties for a 60-day continuance of the hearing scheduled for April 1, 1999; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 1999, the Board, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.01, Subd. 16, ordered the City of Detroit Lakes and the Town of Lake View to meet up to three times over a period of sixty days to address resolution of issues; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was convened on said petition on April 1, 1999 and was continued to June 3, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the parties met and continued meeting to address various issues; and

WHEREAS, the parties submitted to the Municipal Board a Joint Agreement and a Waiver of Objection by the Town of Lake View; and

WHEREAS, the parties requested the June 3, 1999 continued hearing be canceled and the file be closed.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the petition for annexation to the City of Detroit Lakes is dismissed, the June 3, 1999 continued hearing is hereby canceled and the file is closed. The property description in said file is described as follows:

That portion of Section 9, T138N, R41W of the Fifth Principal Meridian, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the east quarter corner of said Section 9, thence north, along the east line of said Section 9, 612.66 feet; thence westerly, along the current centerline of C.S.A.H., No. 24, 185.20 feet; thence southerly, 258.80 feet, thence westerly, 512.61 feet; thence southwesterly 78.10 feet; thence southeasterly, along the northeasterly right of way line of C.S.A.H. No. 22, 532.05 feet, thence westerly, along the south line of said Government Lot 3, 144.91 feet; thence southerly, along the southwesterly right of way line of C.S.A.H. No. 22, 490.23 feet to a point measured 341.12 feet southerly and parallel to the south line of said Government Lot 3; thence easterly 158.85; thence northerly 341.39 feet; thence easterly 91.69 feet to the point of beginning. Bearing and distances are meant to traverse known property lines and stop at known property corners. Said tract contains 8.4 acres (364,217 sq. ft.)

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is May 20, 1999.
