RESOLUTION AND RIGHT TO OBJECT TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY LOCATED ON THE EASTERLY BORDER OF THE CITY OF MADISON LAKE IN JAMESTOWN TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, territory as described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, the territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the City of Madison Lake on the easterly boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban or suburban in character; and

WHEREAS, one hundred percent (100%) of the property owners have petitioned the City of Madison Lake to annex the property described; and

WHEREAS, the area to be annexed is less than 60 acres, and

WHEREAS, the area to be annexed is not presently served by public sewer facilities and public sewer facilities are not otherwise available; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Jamestown does not contemplate providing public sewer facilities for the benefit of its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JAMESTOWN, BLUE EARTH COUNTY, MINNESOTA, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Town Board waives any right it m ay have to object the annexation of the following described tract of land currently located in the Township of Jamestown, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, legally described as follows, to-wit:
