## AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN LANDS

The Council of the City of Kensington, Douglas County, Minnesota, does ordain:

Section 1. <u>Petition to Annex Approved.</u> The Petition For An Annexation of Real Property to The City of Kensington submitted by Independent School District No. 2342 is hereby approved.

Section 2. Lands Annexed. The lands legally described as follows:

That part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 28, Township 127N, Range 40W, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 28, Township 127N, Range 40W, thence West on the South line of the Northeast Quarter a distance of 493 feet, thence North a distance of 284 feet thence East a distance of 493 feet to the east line of Section 28, thence South on the East line of Section 28 a distance of 284 feet to the point of beginning, containing 3.21 acres more or less and subject to County of Douglas Roadway easement.

That part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 28, Township 127N, Range 40 W, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point 493 feet West of the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 28, Township 127N, Range 40W, thence West 60 feet, thence North 334 feet, thence East a distance of 553 feet to the East line of Section 28, thence South on the East line of Section 28, a distance of 50 feet, thence West 493 feet, thence South 284 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.02 acres more or less and subject to County of Douglas roadway easement.
