#### ORDINANCE NO. 209

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY 60% SURROUNDED
BY LAND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

Lake View General Store Area (MMB Docket #A-6050)

WHEREAS, Certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city or borough; and

WHEREAS, This territory is more than 60% surrounded by lands already included within the corporate limits of the City and is deemed to be urban or suburban in character.

The City Council of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota does hereby ordain:

Section 1. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. The corporate limits of the City of Detroit Lakes are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, which territory now, is, and heretofore been completely surrounded by territory already included within the City limits:

That portion of Section 9, T138N, R41W of the Fifth Principal Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the east quarter corner of said Section 9, thence north, along the east line of said Section 9, 612.66 feet; thence westerly, along the current centerline on C.S.A.H, No 24, 185.20 feet; thence southerly, 258.80 feet, thence westerly, 512.61 feet; thence southwesterly 78.10 feet; thence southeasterly, along the northeasterly right of way line of C.S.A.H. No. 22, 532.05 feet, thence westerly, along the south line of said Government Lot 3, 144.91 feet; thence southerly, along the southwesterly right of way line of C.S.A.H. No 22, 490.23 feet to a point measured 341.12 feet southerly and parallel to the south line of said Government Lot 3; thence easterly 158.85; thence northerly 341.39 feet; thence easterly 91.69 feet to the point of beginning. Bearing and distances are meant to traverse known property lines and stop at known property corners. Said tract contains 8.4 acres (364,217 sq. ft.)

WHEREAS, The above described land is forty (40) acres or less in area and 60 percent or more of its perimeter is bordered by land within the City of Detroit Lakes; and

WHEREAS, The area contains four households and has an estimated population of nine.

Section 2. <u>Filing</u>. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the County in which the property is located, the Township Clerk of the affected Township, and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

Section 3. <u>Population</u>. The population of the annexed territory is nine.

Section 4. <u>Effective Date of Annexation</u>. This Ordinance takes effect after publication, the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2, and approval by the Minnesota Planning.

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

- 3) The annexation shall be effective on or after January 1, 2001.
- 4) The Lake View Township Board agrees to withdraw its objection to annexation and to notify the Minnesota Municipal Board of the withdrawal of its objection.
