Section 3. The corporate limits of the City of Brownsdale are hereby extended to include the Property and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City of Brownsdale as if the property had originally been part thereof.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordiance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, Red Rock Township, the Mower County Auditor, and the Minnesota Secretary of State.




