The attached letter dated January 16, 2002, was sent to Minnesota Planning objecting to an annexation petition of 127.978 acres of land into the City of Shakopee (your file A-6607 Shakopee). This letter stated the reason for the objection was based on the lack of a formal annexation agreement.

This letter is being sent to formally withdraw Jackson Township's objection to the current annexation petition, based on the fact that Jackson Township and the City of Shakopee have executed an Orderly Annexation Agreement. On August 20, 2002, at its regular monthly meeting, the Jackson Town Board has passed a motion to withdraw the objection.

Copies of the Orderly Annexation Agreement and Joint Powers Agreement (related to the establishment of a Joint Orderly Annexation Board) will be forwarded to Minnesota Planning by Scott County in the near future.
