ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF UNDERWOOD TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED BY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT #550 AND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, the territory described below is 60 acres or less in size; and

WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the city at the southerly boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban or suburban in character; and

WHEREAS, this territory is owned in fee by Independent School District #550 which has petitioned the city of Underwood to annex the territory described below.

The City Council of Underwood ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city of Underwood are hereby extended to include the property described as follows:

All that part of Government Lots Three (3) and Four (4), Section Five (5), Township One Hundred Thirty-two (132), Range Forty-one (41), lying East of the centerline of County Highway #35 and North of the centerline of State Highway #210, except existing highways and subject to easements of record.

Section 2. Filing. The city clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property was located, the Town Clerk of the effected township and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon the passage, publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.
