## **RESOLUTION NO. 4986**

## A RESOLUTION TO SERVE NOTICE OF INTENT TO ANNEX CEDAR LANE PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414.031 and 414.033, Subd. 3

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, the described territory is urban or suburban or about to become so; and

WHEREAS, the described territory abuts the corporate limits of the City of Bemidji in the northern portion of the City on at least three sides; and

WHEREAS, approximately 78 percent (78%) of the perimeter of this territory is bordered by the City of Bernidji, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bemidji can provide the needed sanitary sewer services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEMIDJI, MINNESOTA, that we hereby serve Notice of Intent to annex the following described property into the corporate limits of the City of Bemidji, to the Minnesota Planning Agency, Township of Northern, and the County of Beltrami.

The three (3) blocks of Cedar Lane including 30<sup>th</sup> Street, Beltrami County State Aid Highway (CSAH) No. 52 (also known as Anne Street), and Beltrami County State Aid Highway (CSAH) No. 15 (also known as Irvine Avenue) Rights-of-way, legally described as the East 450 feet of the East One-half of the Southeast Quarter, Section 32, Township 147N, Range 33W, less Lot One (1), Dickinson's Subdivision previously annexed into the City of Bemidji (Bender parcel); together with the West 50 feet of the South 1,286.69 feet of Section 33, Township 147N, Range 33W (Irvine Avenue right-of-way); and together with all that portion of CSAH No. 52 (Anne Street) extending 750 feet West from the East section line of Section 32, Township 147N, Range 33W.
