ORDINANCE NO. 19-2001AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CITY-OWNED PROPERTY
INTO THE CITY OF WALKER CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, certain property, described below, is not presently included in the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the property is abutting the city limits of the City of Walker; and

WHEREAS, the land is owned by the City of Walker; and

WHEREAS, the legal description of the property is as follows, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter of Section Twenty-one (21), except that part of the Southwest Quarter lying Northerly and Easterly of the existing centerline of Township Road No. 10; and

The Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty-eight (28); all in Township One Hundred Forty-two (142) North, Range Thirty-one (31) West, Cass County, Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council of the City of Walker hereby ordains that the corporate limits of the City of Walker are hereby extended to include the land described above, and the same is hereby annexed and included within the City of Walker as effectively as if it had originally been a part thereof.

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its passage, due publication thereof, and approval by the Minnesota Planning Agency.


