ORDINANCE NO. 343, SECOND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAINT PETER, MINNESOTA ANNEXING LAND LOCATED WITHIN THE TOWN OF TRAVERSE, NICOLLET COUNTY, MINNESOTA PURSUANT TO MINN. STAT. 414.033, SUBD. 2, PERMITTING ANNEXATION BY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city and abuts the corporate limits of the City of Saint Peter, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, this territory is deemed to be urban or suburban in character; and

WHEREAS, a petition requesting annexation has been received signed by all owners of property within the territory subject to annexation by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the property to be annexed includes approximately 29.06 acres of land; and

WHEREAS, there are no human inhabitants of the territory subject to annexation by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the territory to be annexed is not currently served by City owned water or sanitary sewer services; and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission, the City Council has determined that the annexation of the subject territory is not contrary to the implementation of the Comprehensive Plan of the City; and

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2003, the Planning and Zoning Commission conducted a public hearing regarding the annexation of the subject property and recommended that the City Council approve the annexation as petitioned.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAINT PETER, NICOLLET COUNTY, MINNESOTA DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

<u>Section 1</u>. Territory Annexed. Pursuant to Minnesota Statute 414.033, the corporate limits of the City of Saint Peter are hereby extended by annexation of the property described as follows:

The following was provided in Old Republic National Title Insurance Company Commitment Number TL 114006, Effective date November 8, 2002, at 7:45 a.m., Schedule A.

All that part of the West Half of the Northeast Quarter (W 1/2 of NE 1/4) and all that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE 1/4 of NE 1/4) in Section Nine (9). Township 110 North, Range 26 West, Nicollet County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at the center of Section 9, Township 110 North, Range 26 West; thence North 87 degrees 18 minutes 42 seconds East (assumed bearing) along the East-West centerline of Section 9, a distance of 746.17 feet; thence North 74 degrees 39 minutes 12 seconds East, 989.10 feet; thence North 15 degrees 59 minutes 00 seconds West, 205.0 feet; thence South 74 degrees 39 minutes 12 seconds West, 170.00 feet; thence North 15 degrees 59 minutes 00 seconds West, 25.00 feet; thence South 74 degrees 39 minutes 12 seconds West, 66.67 feet; thence North 15 degrees 59 minutes 00 seconds West, 140.00 feet; thence North 74 degrees 39 minutes 12 seconds East, 56.67 feet; thence North 15 degrees 59 minutes 00 seconds West, 379.37 feet; thence South 74 degrees 38 minutes 12 seconds West, 905.82 feet; thence North 16 degrees 01 minutes 48 seconds West, 737.85 feet; thence South 74 degrees 38 minutes 12 seconds West, 276.10 feet, to a point on the North-South centerline of Section 9; thence South 01 degrees 00 minutes 48 seconds East along said North-South centerline 65.53 feet to a point on the North line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter; thence South along the West line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9 to the point of beginning, EXCEPTING THEREFROM the following: All that part lying southerly of Line A: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 110 North, Range 26 West, thence North 87 degrees 18 minutes 42 seconds East (assumed bearing) on the South line of said Northeast Quarter, a distance of 621.95 feet; thence North 15 degrees 59 minutes 00 second West, 2.78 feet; thence North 74 degrees 39 minutes 12 seconds East, 1080.00 feet; thence North 15 degrees 59 minutes 00 second West on the westerly line of Third Street in the Plat of Traverse Des Sioux, 20.00 feet, being the point of beginning of Line A; thence South 74 degrees 39 minutes 12 seconds West, 953.08 feet; thence South 87 degrees 18 minutes 42 seconds West, 739.08 feet to the West line of said Northeast Quarter and there terminating.

Section 2. Filing. The City Administrator is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Nicollet County, the Town Clerk of Traverse Township and Minnesota Planning Boundary Adjustments.

<u>Section 3</u>. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage, publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2, and its approval by the Minnesota Municipal Board, now known as Minnesota Planning Municipal Boundary Adjustments.

Section 4. Zoning. Upon annexation, the land is to be classified as a combination of R-1 Single Family Residential, R-3 Multi-family Residential and C-4 Highway Service Commercial as petitioned by the owner.

<u>Section 5.</u> Official Map. The Community Development Director is directed to change the Official Zoning Map to reflect the new boundary of the City resulting from annexation of the property and to depict its zoning classification.

<u>Section 6</u>. Adoption of General Provisions. All the provisions of Chapter 1, of the Saint Peter City Code are made a part hereof and applicable to this Ordinance.
