

Ordinance No. 84

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TOWER ANNEXING LAND LOCATED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF KUGLER, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MINNESOTA, AND THE TOWNSHIP OF BREITUNG, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, TO THE CITY OF TOWER, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MINNESOTA, PURSUANT TO MINN.STAT. #414.033, PERMITTING ANNEXATION BY ORDINANCE.

The City of Tower Ordains:

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated City; and

WHEREAS, the territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the City of Tower and is deemed to be urban or suburban in character; and

WHEREAS, Parcel #1 is less than sixty acres, abuts the City, and petitioned for annexation;

WHEREAS, Parcel #2 is completely surrounded by the corporate limits of the City of Tower;

Therefore, be it resolved that the corporate limits of the City of Tower are hereby extended to include the property listed as follows:

- 1. Parcel #1: That part of Government Lot 1, Section 6, Township 61 North, Range 15 West, lying south of the southerly right of way line of State Highway 169 in Kugler Township;**
- 2. Parcel #2: West 660 feet of South 440 feet of SW1/4 of NE1/4 Section 32, Township 62 North, Range 15 W, in Breitung Township.**

The City Clerk/Treasurer is directed to file certified copies of the Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the County in which the property is located, the Clerks of affected Townships, and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication, the filing of certified copies as directed and upon the approval of the State Municipal Board.

Introduced and given first reading on March 11, 2002 by Mayor Stephen Abrahamson.

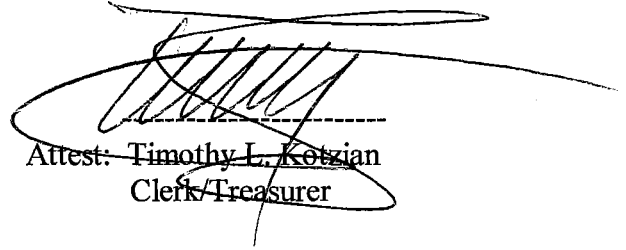
Given second reading by Mayor Stephen Abrahamson on May 13, 2002.
