## **ORDINANCE NO. 85**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TOWER ANNEXING LAND LOCATED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF KUGLER, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MINNESOTA, PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTE #414.033, PERMITTING ANNEXATION BY ORDINANCE.

The City of Tower ordains:

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated City; and

WHEREAS, the territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the City of Tower and is deemed to be urban or suburban in character; and

WHEREAS, the territory is completely owned by the City of Tower.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the corporate limits of the City of Tower are hereby extended to include the property listed as follows.

Parcel 1: NW ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 4, Township 61 W, Range 15 W in the Township of Kugler.

Parcel 2: NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 5, Township 61 W, Range 15 W in the Township of Kugler.

Parcel 3: SW ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 6, Township 61 W, Range 15 W in the Township of Kugler.

Parcel 4: That part of Lot One (1), Section Six (6), Township Sixty-one 61), North of Range Fifteen (15), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, lying North of U.S. Highway 169 right of way in the Township of Kugler.

The City Clerk/Treasurer is directed to file certified copies of the Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the County in which the property is located, the Clerks of affected Townships, and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication, the filing of certified copies as directed and upon the approval of the State Municipal Board.
