**ORDER APPROVING
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On November 7, 2017, the City of Isanti (City) adopted Ordinance Number 681 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Isanti Township (Township) legally described as follows:

The West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 35 North, Range 23 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, Isanti County, Minnesota.

And

The Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter and the westerly 495 feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 35 North, Range 23 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, Isanti County, Minnesota.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2016), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2016), the City will reimburse the Township \$846.87 each year for three years as stated in Ordinance Number 681.

NOTICE

This Order is the final administrative order in this case under Minn. Stat. §§ 414.033, .07, .09, .12 (2016). Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7 requires that a copy of the annexation ordinance be filed with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State.

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.07, subd. 2, any person aggrieved by this Order may appeal to Isanti County District Court by filing an Application for Review with the Court Administrator within 30 days of this Order. An appeal does not stay the effect of this Order.

Any party may submit a written request for an amendment of this Order within seven days from the date of the mailing of the Order pursuant to Minn. R. 6000.3100 (2017). However, no request for amendment shall extend the time of appeal from this Order.
