**ORDER APPROVING  
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On August 27, 2018, the City of La Crescent (City) adopted Ordinance Number 523 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from La Crescent Township (Township) legally described as follows:

Lot Twelve (12), Block Two (2), Crescent Valley First Addition, La Crescent Township, Houston County, Minnesota.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City will reimburse the Township \$548.95 each year for two years as stated in Ordinance Number 523.
4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
