**ORDER APPROVING  
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On May 8, 2019, the City of Eden Valley (City) adopted Ordinance Number 2019-2 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Manannah Township (Township) legally described as follows:

That part of the West Half of the Southeast Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 3, Township 121, Range 31, Meeker County, Minnesota, lying North of the South 1980 feet of the West Half of the Southeast Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 3, Township 121, Range 31, Meeker County, Minnesota.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City will reimburse the Township \$153.30 over a period of two years as stated in Ordinance Number 2019-2.
4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
