**ORDER APPROVING  
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On May 14, 2019, the City of Isle (City) adopted Ordinance Number 161 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Isle Harbor Township (Township) legally described as follows:

The South Half of the Northwest Quarter (S½ of NW¼) Except:

The East 270 feet of the West 490 feet of the South 404 feet as measured at right angles of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Section 13, Township 42, Range 25, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, containing 2.5 acres more or less.

and

The West 220 feet of the South 404 feet, as measured at right angles, of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, together with the East 50 feet of the South 404 feet as measured at right angles, of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Section 13, Township 42, Range 25, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, containing 2.5 acres more or less.


Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to the agreement of the parties and as allowed by Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City shall reimburse the Township as stated in the Ordinance.

4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
