In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Lindstrom from Chisago Lake Township (MBAU Docket A-8218)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On July 9, 2019, the City of Lindstrom (City) filed a Notice of Intent to Annex pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 3 (2018) with the Office of Administrative Hearings.

No objection by the Chisago Lake Town Board (Township) was served pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 3.

On October 17, 2019, the City adopted Ordinance Number 20191017-01 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) legally described as follows:

Lot 3, Block 1, Shady Rest Addition, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder in and for Chisago County, Minnesota. (PID 02-01603-00).

That part of the Public Highway, also known as Lake Lane, as dedicated per CURRIE BEACH, according to the plat on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder, Chisago County, Minnesota, which lies easterly of the southerly extension of the westerly line of Lot 3, Block 1, SHADY REST ADDITION and westerly of the southerly extension of the easterly line of said Lot 3, Block 1, SHADY REST ADDITION, according to the plat on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder, Chisago County, Minnesota.

EXCEPT

All land which has previously been annexed into the city.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.

- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
- 3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City will reimburse the Township \$297.40 as stated in Ordinance Number 20191017-01.
- 4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
