## STATE OF MINNESOTA OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS

In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Rothsay from Trondhjem Township (MBAU Docket A-8223)

## ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On July 22, 2019, the City of Rothsay (City) adopted Ordinance Number 10.03 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Trondhjem Township (Township) legally described as follows:

That part of Government Lot 1 and that part of Government Lot 2 and that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>), all being within Section 31, Township 135 North, Range 44 West, Otter Tail County Minnesota, described as follow:

Beginning at the west quarter corner of said Section 31;

Thence North 00 degrees 21 minutes 05 seconds East, assumed bearing along the west line of said Section 31, a distance of 1222.08 feet;

Thence North 73 degrees 38 minutes 10 seconds East, 404.48 feet to the westerly right-of-way line of the Otter Tail Valley Railroad;

Thence South 33 degrees 41 minutes 21 seconds East, along said westerly rightof-way line, 1621.50 feet to the east-west quarter line of said Section 31;

Thence North 89 degrees 25 minutes 03 seconds West, along said east-west quarter line, 1295.09 feet to the point of beginning.

The tract contains 25.35 acres more or less, subject to any easements of record, including an existing public roadway easement over the westerly portion thereof (C.S.A.H. No. 11).

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

## ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.

2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.

3. As there is no taxable property within the Property, the provisions of Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), are not applicable.

4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
