## ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On September 2, 2019, the City of Winthrop (City) adopted Ordinance Number 2019-133 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Alfsborg Township (Township) legally described as follows:

The East one hundred fifty-five (155) feet of the North two hundred sixty-three (263) feet of Out-Lot Number Nineteen (19) in THORSON'S AND SWENSON'S SUBDIVISION situated in Section Number Six (6), Township Number One Hundred Twelve (112) North of Range Number Twenty-Nine (29) West, in Sibley County Minnesota.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

## ORDER

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
- 3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City will reimburse the Township \$67.83 each year for five years as stated in Ordinance Number 2019-133.
- 4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
