

ORDINANCE NO. 454

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED LAND SURROUNDED BY THE CITY LIMITS (LONG LAKE)

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held and proper notice was sent to the property owners within and adjacent to the annexation area and to the town board or the government body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory is completely surrounded by all sides by lands already included within the corporate limits of the City and is deemed to be urban or suburban in character; NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, does hereby ordain:

- Section 1. The City Council hereby determines: 1) that the territory described herein is completely surrounded by the City limits and is urban or suburban in character; and 2) that none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city.
- Section 2. The population of the territory is 0
- Section 3. The territory to be annexed is 414.52 acres, more or less with approximately 6.5 acres in Lake View Township and approximately 408.2 acres in Detroit Township
- Section 4. The territory annexed is known as Long Lake
- Section 5. <u>Territory Annexed.</u> The corporate limits of the City of Detroit Lakes are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows and the same hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had been originally been a part thereof:

The body of water known as Long Lake and designated by Minnesota Department of Natural Resources Number 383. That portion of Long Lake in Detroit Township is 408.12 acres and that portion of Long Lake in Lake View Township is 6.5 acres for a total of 414.52 acres.

- Section 6. <u>Municipal Boundary Adjustments</u> The City Administrator is directed to forward this ordinance to the Office of Administrative hearings upon approval and passage.
- Section 7. Reimbursement to Township Since the territory to be annexed is Long Lake, a public water, there is no reimbursement to the Township.

- Section 8. Filing The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with, the Office of Administrative Hearings, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk, and the County Auditor.
- Section 9. <u>Effective Date of Annexation</u> This Ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 8, and approval as required by State Law.
