ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On December 10, 2019, the City of Detroit Lakes (City) adopted Ordinance Number 456 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Detroit Township legally described as follows:

All that portion of land in Section 22, Township 139 North, Range 41 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian described as follows: All that portion of said Section 22 which is currently 100% surrounded by the current Corporate Limits of Detroit Lakes. Said Tract contains 215.5 acres more or less.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
- 3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City will reimburse the Township \$9,370.81 each year for five years as stated in Ordinance No. 456.
- 4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with Detroit Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
