In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Albert Lea from Bancroft Township (MBAU Docket A-8255)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On March 10, 2020, the City of Albert Lea (City) adopted Ordinance Number 20-288 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Bancroft Township legally described as follows:

All that part of the NE¼ Section 28-T103N-R21W, Freeborn County, Minnesota; described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of the SE¼ of said Section 28; thence North 00°41′11″ West a distance of 3038.15 feet on an assumed bearing on the North-South line of said Section 28, to the northwest corner of a tract described in Book 182 of Deeds at Page 441 in the office of the Freeborn County Recorder, which is the point of beginning;

thence South 89°32'11" East a distance of 1089.00 feet, to the northeast corner of said tract;

thence North 00°41'11" West a distance of 137.29 feet, parallel with the said west line;

thence North 89°59'52" East a distance of 613.89 feet, parallel with the south line of said NE¼;

thence North 00°33'57" West a distance of 571.55 feet, to the north line of the South 1100.58 feet of said NE¼;

thence South 89°59'52" West a distance of 1703.95 feet, to the northwest corner of said South 1100.58 feet;

thence South 00°41'11" East a distance of 700.00 feet on said west line, to the point of beginning;

subject to highway easement on the west side thereof.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
- 3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City will reimburse the Township \$34.06 each year for two years as stated in Ordinance No. 20-228.
- 4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with Bancroft Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
