In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Rochester from Cascade Township (MBAU Docket A-8279)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On July 20, 2020, the City of Rochester (City) adopted Ordinance No. 4408 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Cascade Township (Township) legally described as follows:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 107 North, Range 14 West, Olmsted County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 6; thence South 89 degrees 52 minutes 37 seconds East, assumed bearing, along the south line of said Southeast Quarter, 1670.73 feet to a point which is 962.38 feet westerly of the southeast corner of said Southeast Quarter; thence North 00 degrees 07 minutes 58 seconds West, parallel to the east line of said Southeast Quarter, 1041.32 feet; thence North 89 degrees 52 minutes 37 seconds West, parallel to the south line of said Southeast Quarter, 1675.82 feet to the west line of said Southeast Quarter; thence South 00 degrees 24 minutes 46 seconds East, along said west line, 1041.36 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 40.00 acres more or less.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2020), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.

2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.

3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2020), the City will reimburse the Township as stated in Ordinance No. 4408.

4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
