In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Moorhead from Moorhead Township (MBAU Docket A-8322)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On January 25, 2021, the City of Moorhead (City) adopted Ordinance No. 2020-14 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Moorhead Township (Township) legally described as follows:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 139 North, Range 48 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Clay County, Minnesota, described as follows:

COMMENCING at the northwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 29; thence South 00°23'05" East (assumed bearing), along the west line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 29, for a distance of 26.00 feet to the southwest corner of Stonemill Estates First Addition, on file at the Clay County Recorder's Office; thence North 89°44'11" East, along the south line of said Stonemill Estates First Addition, for a distance of 292.00 feet to a point of intersection with the east line of a tract of land described in Document No. 432753, on file at said Recorder's Office, and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continue North 89°44'11" East, along the south line of said Stonemill Estates First Addition, for a distance of 431.17 feet to a point of tangential curve to the left, radius 221.00 feet; thence easterly, along said curve to the left and along the south line of said Stonemill Estates First Addition, for a distance of 108.28 feet, through a central angle of 28°04'21", chord bearing North 75°42'00" East; thence North 89°44'11" East, along the south line of said Stonemill Estates First Addition, for a distance of 47.75 feet to the northeast corner of a tract of land described in Document No. 726399, on file at said Recorder's Office; thence South 00°23'05" East, along the east line of a tract of land described in said Document No. 726399, for a distance of 472.29 feet to a point of intersection with the north line of Mar-Brak Subdivision, on file at said Recorder's Office; thence North 89°56'52" West, along the north line of said Mar-Brak Subdivision, for a distance of 628.00 feet to the southeast corner of a tract of land described in Document No. 448160, on file at said Recorder's Office; thence North 00°23'05" West, along the east line of a tract of land described in said Document No. 448160, for a distance of 279.78 feet to the northeast corner of a tract of land described in said

Document No. 448160, said corner also being the southwest corner of a tract of land described in said Document No. 432753; thence South 89°53'45" East, along the south line of a tract of land described in said Document No. 432753, for a distance of 45.00 feet to the southeast corner of a tract of land described in said Document No. 432753; thence North 00°23'05" West, along the east line of a tract of land described in said Document No. 432753, for a distance of 163.34 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2020), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
- 3. Pursuant to the agreement of the parties and as allowed by Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2020), the City will reimburse the Township \$89 each year for two years as stated in the Ordinance.
- 4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
