In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of North Mankato from Belgrade Township (MBAU Docket A-8323)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On March 15, 2021, the City of North Mankato (City) adopted Ordinance No. 140 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Belgrade Township (Township) legally described as follows:

The South 113 feet of the West 32 feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 109 North, Range 27 West, Nicollet County, Minnesota and the South 113 feet of the East 128 feet of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section of Section 34, Township 109 North, Range 27 West, Nicollet County, Minnesota. Except any land already within the city limits. Containing 0.42 acres.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2020), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.

2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.

3. As there is no taxable property within the Property, the provisions of Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2020) are not applicable.

4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
