**ORDER APPROVING  
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On May 17, 2021, the City of Lakeville (City) adopted Ordinance No. 1045 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Eureka Township (Township) legally described as follows:

The West 1980.00 feet of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3, Township 113, Range 20, Dakota County, Minnesota EXCEPT the South 690 feet of the East 631.30 feet of said West 1980.00 feet.

AND

The South 690 feet of the East 315.65 feet of the West 1664.35 feet of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3, Township 113, Range 20, Dakota County, Minnesota.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2020), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2020), the City will reimburse the Township \$788.08 each year for two years as stated in Ordinance No. 1045.
4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
