In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Austin from Austin Township (MBAU Docket A-8354)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On August 16, 2021, the City of Austin (City) adopted Ordinance No. 694 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Austin Township (Township) legally described as follows:

Commencing at a point 293.5 feet North of the Southwest corner of Out Lot 2 in Plat of Out Lots in Section 15, Township 102 North, Range 18 West, thence North along the West side of said Out Lot 2, 155 feet, thence running East parallel with the South line of Out Lot 2 to the center of the river, thence South along the center of the river to a point directly East of the place of beginning, thence West parallel with the South line of said Out Lot 2 to the place of beginning.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2020), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
- 3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2020), the City will reimburse the Township \$72.27 each year for two years as stated in the Ordinance.
- 4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
