ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On September 14, 2021, the City of Faribault (City) adopted Ordinance No. 2021-8 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Walcott Township (Township) legally described as follows:

All that area within the N½ of the NW¼ of Section 8, Township 109, Range 20, Rice County, lying north of the southerly right-of-way line of Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad as shown on Document A757110, also known as Survey Plat of the City of Faribault Nature Interpretive Center.

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2022), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
- 3. As there is no taxable property within the Property, the provisions of Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2022) are not applicable.
- 4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
