In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Cottonwood from Lucas Township (MBAU Docket A-8411)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On June 28, 2022, the City of Cottonwood (City) adopted Ordinance No. 2022-03 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Lucas Township (Township) legally described as follows:

All that part of Government Lot 3 in Section 5, Township 113 North, Range 40 West, Lyon County, Minnesota, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 1 Block 1 of Idso 2nd Addition to the City of Cottonwood as filed and recorded in the Office of the County Recorder in and for said Lyon County; thence South 89 degrees 11 minutes 53 seconds West, bearing based on Lyon County Coordinate System (1996 Adj.), along the south line of Government Lot 3, a distance of 50.00 feet; thence North 00 degrees 48 minutes 07 seconds West a distance of 300.00 feet; thence North 56 degrees 51 minutes 04 seconds East a distance of 386 feet, more or less, to a point on the shoreline of Cottonwood Lake, said point here after known as Point "A"; beginning again from said point of beginning, thence North 89 degrees 11 minutes 53 seconds East, along the south line of said Government Lot 3, a distance of 331 feet, more or less, to a point on the shoreline of Cottonwood Lake; thence northerly, along said shoreline, a distance of 550 feet, more or less, to said Point "A", description there terminating.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2022), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
- 3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2022), the City will reimburse the Township \$10 each year for two years as stated in Ordinance No. 2022-03.

4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
