**CORRECTED
ORDER APPROVING
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On March 20, 2023, the City of Hastings (City) adopted Ordinance No. 2023-03 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Marshan Township (Township) legally described as follows:

That part of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 2, Township 114, Range 17, Dakota County, Minnesota lying north and east of CSAH #316, except that Parcel 16 MN DOT ROW Plat 19-138.

AND


That part of the west 100 acres of the Northwest Quarter of Section 11, Township 114, Range 17, Dakota County, Minnesota lying north and east of CSAH #316, except that Parcel 16 MN DOT ROW Plat 19-138.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2022), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2022), the City will reimburse the Township \$408.24 each year for two years as stated in the Ordinance.
4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor, and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.

NOTICE
