**ORDER APPROVING  
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On May 1, 2023, the City of Long Prairie (City) adopted Ordinance No. 23-05-01-01 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Long Prairie Township (Township) legally described as follows:

S½ of SW¼, Section 8, Township 129, Range 33, and Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, Block 1, Isensee's Acres, according to the plat thereof, now on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder, Todd County, Minnesota.

AND


That part of the SW¼ of SE¼ lying and being west of the west right-of-way of U.S. Highway No. 71, Section 8, Township 129 N, Range 33 W of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2022), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2022), the City will reimburse the Township \$496.54 each year for two years as stated in the Ordinance.
4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor, and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
