RESOLUTION CITY OF FRANKLIN

AT THE regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Franklin held on September 2, 1993, the following resolution was duly passed:

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Franklin that the City of Franklin approves the consolidation of the City of Franklin with the City of Virginia and further approves the ; commencement of the necessary proceedings pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 414 to accomplish said consolidation subject to agreement or in compliance with the following specific conditions:

- A. That upon consolidation no liquor licenses will be issued for premises within the area of the City of Franklin.
- B. That appropriate ordinances and regulations shall be enacted to protect the quiet enjoyment of the residential area of the City of Franklin including restriction upon heavy industry and commercial and industrial traffic within the City of Franklin.
- C. That sufficient zoning and other regulations be enacted to assure sufficient buffer zone between any industrial or commercial zoned area and the existing residential area of the City of Franklin in order to maintain its residential character and the quiet enjoyment thereof by the residents of the City of Franklin.

- D. That this resolution for consolidation is expressly contingent upon the current property owners resident within the City of Franklin receiving clear and marketable fee simple title to their existing leasehold properties for the consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) each and that all parcels conveyed to the existing property owners within the City of Franklin be properly surveyed and platted pursuant to city and St. Louis County platting requirements and that each owner within the City of Franklin receive an Abstract of Title or, in the event that the property is registered under the torrens system, a Certificate of Title and Registered Property Abstract to document clear and marketable title in said owners and residents of the City of Franklin. The City of Virginia shall be responsible for all legal costs and expenses incurred in connection with the consolidation proceeding.
- E. That the existing government of the City of Franklin be dissolved with the City of Virginia bearing all legal and financial responsibility for dissolution or other termination of the governing authority within the City of Franklin and that the existing city council of the City of Franklin shall thereupon have no further responsibility or authority in the governance of the area consolidated with the City of Virginia.
- F. The City of Virginia shall take possession of all historical records and documents of the City of Franklin and shall assume responsibility therefor and shall maintain the same in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.
- G. That the City of Franklin shall be entitled to honor all contracts for public improvements and development projects

within the City of Franklin entered into or contracted for prior to the effective date of consolidation and that necessary funds shall be segregated in order to pay for all such contracted for improvements in addition to any other funds determined by the City of Franklin as being necessary to carry out the contracts and legal obligations of the City of Franklin prior to the effective date of consolidation.

H. That the City of Franklin reserves the right to impose additional conditions and contingencies upon the consolidation process as the process proceeds in order that the legal rights and interests of the City of Franklin be protected in the consolidation process.

CHAPTER TWO

Powers of the City

<u>Section 3</u> - <u>General Powers of the City</u> - The City of Virginia shall have and use its present seal, and may alter it at its pleasure; may contract, and be contracted with; may take by purchase, condemnation or otherwise, and hold, lease, sell, or convey all such real and


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
