MINNESOTA STATUTES 414)	

WHEREAS, the Municipal Board has had before it a number of contested proceedings to change the boundaries between the City of Rushford and the City of Rushford Village; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Board invoked Minnesota Statutes 414.01, Subdivision 16, requiring the City of Rushford Village and the City of Rushford together with a representative of Fillmore County, to meet three times over a period of sixty days to discuss issues of mutual concern including consolidation and to work on a foundation for a more efficient, effective, and comprehensive manner of serving the community as a whole; and


WHEREAS, said joint efforts resulted in dialogue between the two cities and a Joint Resolution which calls for a comprehensive professional study and which study, if funded, can assist in providing information to the local consolidation commission; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rushford and the City of Rushford Village share common boundaries, the City of Rushford Village surrounds the City of Rushford;

THEREFORE, the Minnesota Municipal Board, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.041, hereby initiates consolidation proceedings for the Cities of Rushford and Rushford Village.

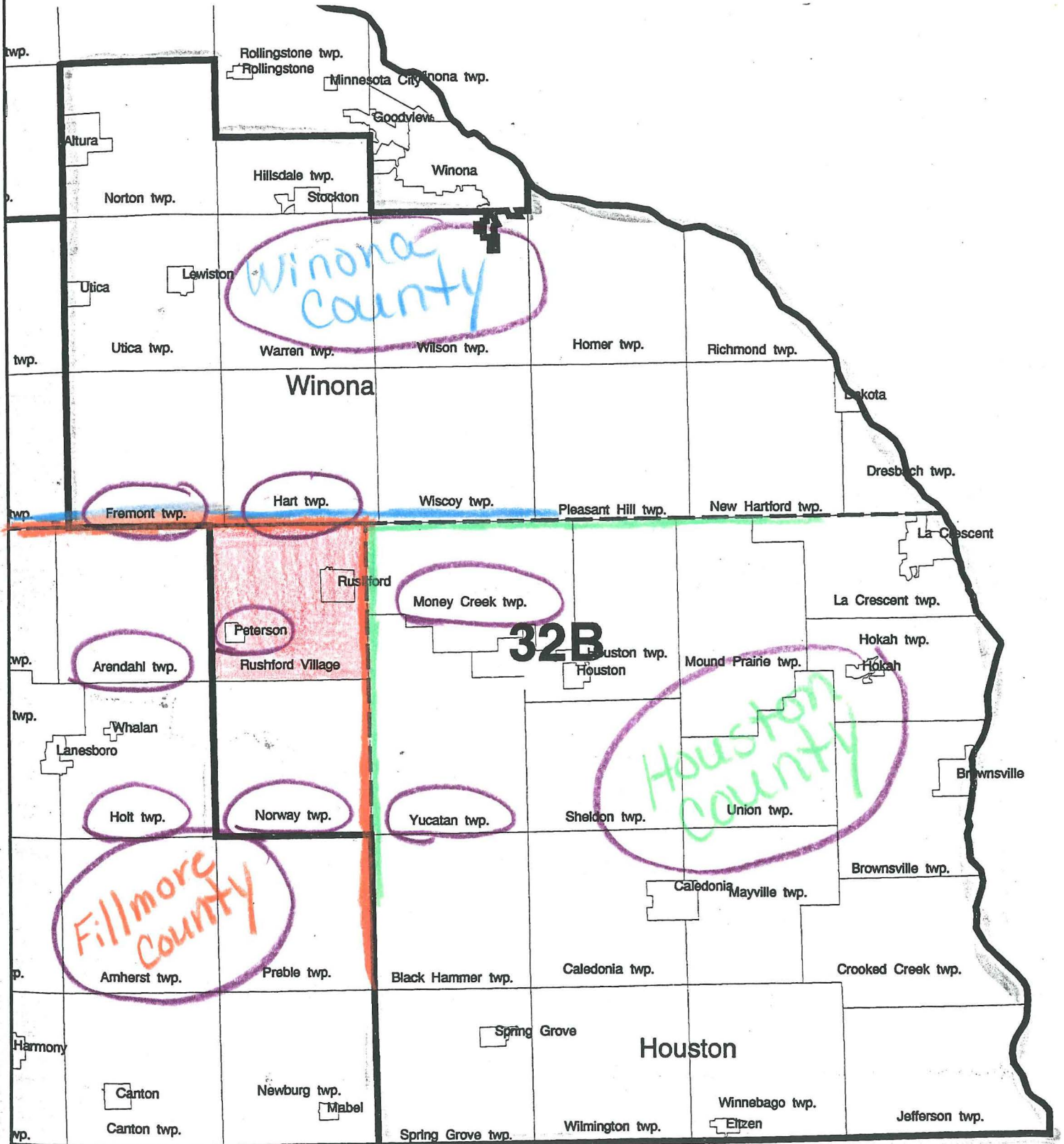
