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IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF THE VILLAGE OF ORONO AND THE CITY OF WAYZATA FOR THE SIMULTANEOUS DETACHMENT AND ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED THEREIN UNDER LAWS 1959, CHAPTER 686, SECTION 6, SUBDIVISION 2 AS AMENDED.

ORDER

The Village of Orono has, by resolution of the Village Council at a meeting held on April 9, 1962, petitioned for the detachment of certain property hereinafter described, and the City of Wayzata has, at a meeting of the City Council held on April 3, 1962, petitioned to annex the same property, pursuant to Laws 1959, Chapter 686, Section 6, subdivision 2 as amended.

The territory involved consists of:

"That part of Southeast 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 of Section 35, Township 118 North, Range 23 West of the First Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing at Southeast corner of said Section 35; thence Westerly along South line of said Section a distance of 826.2 feet to Northeasterly line of Great Northern right of way; thence Northeasterly along said right of way line a distance of 620.8 feet to its intersection with West line of said Southeast 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 of Section 35; thence Northerly along said West line of said Southeast 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 a distance of 29.7 feet; thence Easterly parallel with and distant 385.0 feet measured at right angles from South line of said Section 35 a distance of 1011.05 feet to Southwesterly line of State Highway No. 10, as now laid out and numbered; thence Southwesterly along said Southwesterly line of highway a distance of 392.7 feet to its intersection with East line of said Section 35; thence Southwesterly a distance of 161.0 feet to point of beginning."

All of the requirements of the statute having been met,

IT IS ORDERED: That the above described real property be, and hereby is, detached from the Village of Orono and annexed to the City of Wayzata, the same as if it had originally been a part thereof.
