Quarter thence North along the West line of said Northwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter a distance of 660 feet; thence East and parallel to the South line of said Northwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter a distance of 1,320 feet, more or less, to the East line of said Northwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter; thence South along said East line a distance of 660 feet, more or less, to the Southeast corner of said Northwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter; thence West along the South line of said Northwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter a distance of 1,320 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning and there to terminate.
