

PETITION FOR CONCURRENT DETACHMENT AND ANNEXATION

IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION BY ALL OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS FOR THE CONCURRENT DETACHMENT AND ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN LAND PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTE 414.061, SUBD. 5

We the undersigned, being all of the property owners of the following described land, hereby requests the Department of Administration-Municipal Boundary Adjustments to detach said property from the city of Nashwauk and annex it to the city of Keewatin, pursuant to Minnesota Statute 414.061, Sub. 5:

The property is described as follows:

Section 36, Township 57 North, Range 22 West All of the NE1/4-NE1/4

Section 36, Township 57 North, Range 22 West All off the NW1/4-NE1/4 (Except that small portion which is currently incorporated in the City of Keewatin)_

In bringing forward this petition, the petitioners state that:

- 1. There are 11 property owners in the area proposed for detachment/annexation. (All of the property owners are required to sign a petition under M.S. 414.061, Subd. 5, to commence the proceeding. If the land is owned by both husband and wife, both must sign the petition to represent all owners.)
- 2. The property is presently within the city of Nashwauk and abuts the city of Keewatin on the city's South boundary, in the County of Itasca.
- 3. The property for detachment/annexation is 73.86 acres.
- 4. This boundary adjustment is being requested because:

- a. The road leading to these homes is maintained by the city of Keewatin.
- b. The Keewatin Fire Department responds to these residents for fire or rescue
- c. The Keewatin Police Department responds to these residents for emergencies.
- d. The residents have a Keewatin telephone number prefix
- e. The residents feel they are residents of Keewatin rather than Nashwauk because Keewatin City limits abut their property and the entrance to Nashwauk is seven miles west of them on Highway 169 and there are no other residences between them and Nashwauk.
