IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF THE VILLAGE OF EDINA AND THE CITY OF HOPKINS FOR THE SIMULTANEOUS DETACHMENT AND ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN LANDS DESCRIBED HEREIN

ORDER

The Village of Edina has, by resolution of the Village Council at a meeting held October 21, 1963, petitioned for the detachment of certain property hereinafter described, and the City of Hopkins has, at a meeting of the City Council held October 15, 1963, petitioned to annex the same property pursuant to Chapter 686, Minnesota Laws 1959, Section 6.


The territory involved consists of:

That part of Section 30, Township 117, Range 21 described as follows, viz: commencing at the Northeast corner of said Section 30; thence South along the East line of said section a distance of 75 feet to the Southerly boundary line of the abandoned right-of-way of the Minneapolis, St. Paul and Suburban Railway; thence Westerly along the Southerly line of said right-of-way to the West line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 30; thence Northerly along said West line, a distance of 75 feet more or less, to the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter; thence Easterly to the point of beginning.

All of the requirements of the statute having been met,

IT IS ORDERED: That the above described real property be, and hereby is, detached from the Village of Edina and annexed to the City of Hopkins, the same as if it had originally been a part thereof.
