The City of Hopkins has, by resolution of the City Council at a regular meeting held the 3rd day of March, 1964, petitioned for the detachment of certain property and the Village of Edina has concurrently, by resolution of the Village Council at a regular meeting held the 3rd day of February, 1964, petitioned to annex the same territory, pursuant to Chapter 686, Minnesota Laws 1959, Section 6 as amended by Laws 1963, Chapters 807 and 621.

The territory involved consists of:

All that part of Trolley Line Addition lying North of the South line of Section 19, Township 117, Range 21, except that part thereof lying and being in Outlot 1 of said Trolley Line Addition, all according to the recorded plat thereof

All the requirements of the statute having been met,

IT IS ORDERED: That the above described real property be and is hereby detached from the City of Hopkins and annexed to the Village of Edina, the same as if it had originally been a part thereof.
