
Dear Mr. Stoneberg, Mr. Peterson, Ms. Pagel and Mr. Swanson:

On October 11, 2011 after reviewing all pertinent correspondence in the file, the Chief Administrative Law Judge, through his designee, delegated the authority and responsibility under Minn. Stat. §§ 414.01 to 414.09 to conduct hearings and issue orders, including a final decision in this matter to the Administrative Law Division, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.12 Subd. 2(a).

The Office of Administrative Hearings will assign an administrative law judge to this matter and you will be notified accordingly. This referral to hearing does not preclude the parties from entering mediation at a later date. If the parties wish to go to mediation, they may request the assignment of another administrative law judge to act as a mediator or arrange other mediation. The schedule for mediation must be consistent with the schedule of the administrative law judge assigned for hearing.
