A petition has been filed on the 24th day of November, 1964, by the Village of Dennison, Rice County, State of Minnesota, and all of the owners of the property described herein for the detachment of said land from the Village of Dennison.

The affected property is adjacent to the village boundaries of Dennison. The land is unplatted, occupied and used exclusively for agricultural purposes. The land is not needed for reasonable anticipated future development.

The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Laws 1959, Chapter 411, Minnesota Statutes 1961, as amended by Laws 1963, Chapters 897, and 821 and upon all the files and records, the Municipal Commission being fully advised in the premises.

IT IS ORDERED: That the following described property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the Village of Dennison, County of Rice, State of Minnesota, and made a part of Northfield Township, Rice County, State of Minnesota:

The N1/2 of Sec. 24, T11N of Range 19E, excepting that part detached from the Village of Dennison by Order of the Commission on January 10, 1965.
