ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The underlying Petition for Detachment in this matter was filed on or about October 6, 2014, by John M. Roll and Peggy A. Roll (Petitioners). The City of Bingham Lake (City) passed a resolution opposing the detachment petition on October 13, 2014. On October 23, 2014, the Chief Administrative Law Judge assigned this case to the undersigned Administrative Law Judge. On November 5, 2014, a Notice and Order for Prehearing Conference and Hearing, and Order to Participate in Mediation Session was issued.

After participating in mediation, the Petitioners and the City were able to reach a resolution of their dispute. On April 2, 2015, Petitioners filed the written Settlement Agreement executed by the City and the Petitioners. As part of the Settlement Agreement, the Petitioners withdrew their Petition for Detachment in this matter.



Based upon the filings to date, the Administrative Law Judge issues the following:

ORDER

1. The Petition for Detachment filed by Petitioners with the Office of Administrative Hearings is **DISMISSED**.
2. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.06, subd. 7, the cost of these proceedings to date shall be divided as follows: 50 percent to the Petitioners, and 50 percent to the City. An invoice will be sent memorializing these costs.
3. The Office of Administrative Hearings shall cause copies of this Order to be mailed as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.09, subd. 2 (2014).
