# A JOINT RESOLUTION REQUESTING CONCURRENT DETACHMENT FROM ST. MICHAEL AND ANNEXATION INTO HANOVER OF CERTAIN LANDS PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES SECTION 414.061

WHEREAS, certain real property, legally described in Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Annexation Property") is located in St. Michael; and

WHEREAS, the Annexation Property is located on the border of Hanover that is contiguous to St. Michael; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Annexation Property is owned by Ruha, LLP which consents to the concurrent detachment from St. Michael and annexation into Hanover, and the remainder of the Annexation Property is located within the Crow River; and

WHEREAS, the Annexation Property consists of approximately 3.6 acre to the centerline of the Crow River. It is assumed that the present location of the centerline of the Crow River is coincident with the County boundary between Wright and Hennepin Counties. The intention of this municipal boundary change is to describe land only located within Wright County and including land up to said County boundary; and

WHEREAS, St. Michael and Hanover want the entire Annexation Property to be located within the corporate limits of Hanover; and

WHEREAS, St. Michael and Hanover want to modify their mutual municipal boundary to permit the Annexation Property to be located entirely within Hanover; and

WHEREAS, to modify the boundary, St. Michael desires to detach and Hanover desires to annex the Annexation Property pursuant to Minnesota Statute 414.061.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Cities of St. Michael and Hanover jointly request that the Minnesota Office of Administrative Hearings, Municipal Boundary Adjustment Unit concurrently detach the Annexation Property from the City of St. Michael and annex the same to the City of Hanover at the earliest possible date.
- 2. The City Planner for the City of Hanover is authorized to submit this resolution along with appropriate application materials to the Minnesota Office of Administrative

Hearings, Municipal Boundary Adjustment Unit for the purpose set forth herein. Council members voting in favor:

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
