IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION FOR DETACHMENT OF LAND
FROM THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT LAKE, MINNESOTA

ORDER

The Municipal Commission received a petition for detachment of land from the Village of Pleasant Lake, Minnesota, on the 22nd day of March, 1966, signed by the sole property owners. The Pleasant Lake Village Council voted at a meeting on March 8, 1966, to respect the petitioners request for the detachment.

The territory involved consists of:

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 124,
Range 29, Village of Pleasant Lake, County of
Stearns, Minnesota

The property is unplatted and occupied and is used exclusively for agricultural purposes, and is not needed for reasonable anticipated future development. There are no municipal improvements in said area. The detachment would not unreasonably affect the symmetry of the municipality.

The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minnesota Statutes 414.06 and upon the files and records, the Minnesota Municipal Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED: That the foregoing described real property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the Village of Pleasant Lake and made a part of the Township of St. Joseph.
