**ORDER APPROVING

On March 8, 2022, City Resolution 06-14-21-07 (City Resolution), along with a petition for detachment by all of the property owners (Petition for Detachment), was filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings requesting detachment, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.06 (2020), of certain real property (Property) from the City of Barnesville (City) legally described as follows:
