**ORDER APPROVING  
DETACHMENT**

On November 18, 2022, a Petition for Detachment (Petition for Detachment) was filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings requesting detachment, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.06 (2022), of certain real property (Property) from the City of Storden (City) legally described as follows:

The North 175' of the East ½ of the Northeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of  
Section 30, Township 107, Range 37, Cottonwood County, Minnesota.

On December 6, 2021, the City adopted Resolution 1221 (City Resolution) supporting the Petition for Detachment. The Storden Town Board (Township) adopted Resolution 0321 (Township Resolution) supporting the Petition for Detachment on December 14, 2021. The City Resolution and Township Resolution were received by the Office of Administrative Hearings on November 18, 2022.

Based upon a review of the Petition for Detachment, the City Resolution, and the Township Resolution, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.06, the Petition for Detachment, the City Resolution, and the Township Resolution are deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly support this Order.
2. Pursuant to this Order, the Property is **DETACHED** from the City.
