In the Matter of the Detachment of Certain Real Property from the City of Westbrook to Westbrook Township (MBAU Docket D-659)

ORDER APPROVING DETACHMENT

On November 20, 2023, a Petition for Detachment (Petition for Detachment) was filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings requesting detachment, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.06 (2022), of certain real property (Property) from the City of Westbrook (City) legally described as follows:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ NW¼) of Section 29, Township 107 North, Range 38 West of the 5th P.M., Cottonwood County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing on the Southeast corner of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ NW¼); thence West along the South line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ NW¼), a distance of 183 feet; thence North, parallel with the East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ NW¼), a distance of 201 feet to the point of beginning of the land to be described; thence continuing North, parallel with said East line, a distance of 355 feet; thence West, parallel with said South line, a distance of 300 feet; thence South, parallel with said East line a distance of 355 feet, thence East, parallel with said South line, a distance of 300 feet to the point of beginning. Together will all hereditaments and appurtenances belonging thereto.

On September 5, 2023, the City and the Westbrook Town Board (Township) adopted Joint Resolution No. 8-2023 (Joint Resolution) supporting the Petition for Detachment. The Joint Resolution was received by the Office of Administrative Hearings on November 20, 2023.

Based upon a review of the Petition for Detachment and the Joint Resolution, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.06, the Petition for Detachment and the Joint Resolution are deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly support this Order.

2. Pursuant to this Order, the Property is **DETACHED** from the City.
