IN THE MATTER OF THE RESOLUTIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF RUSHFORD AND THE CITY OF RUSHFORD FOR THE SIMULTANEOUS DETACHMENT AND ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY UNDER M.S.A. 414.06

ORDER

The Village of Rushford has, by resolution of the Village Council at a regular meeting held on February 6, 1968, petitioned for the detachment of certain property and the City of Rushford has concurrently, by resolution of the City Council at a meeting on the 8th day of February, 1968, petitioned to annex the same territory pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.06.

The territory involved consists of:

All that part of the NW½ of SE½ Sec. 11-104-8 lying south and west of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 43 which runs across said 40 acre tract, except the following parcels: "Beginning at a point 526.96 feet south of the NW corner of said NW½ SE½, thence south 279.6 feet, thence east 267.8 feet, to west side of Highway right of way, thence NW'ly 384.7 feet to point of beginning; and Beginning at a point 303 feet east of SW corner of said NW½ SE½, running thence north 28 degrees 28 minutes east to SW'ly boundary of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 43, running thence SE'ly along said highway to the intersection of the SW'ly boundary of said highway with the south line of said NW½ SE½, thence west to the point of beginning.

All the requirements of the statutes having been met,

IT IS ORDERED: That the above described property be and the same hereby is detached from the Village of Rushford and annexed to the City of Rushford, the same as if it had originally been a part thereof.
